Key Stage Three

Teaching at KS3 is based on the National Strategy for Mathematics, following the guidance given by the Framework. Our Schemes of Work address the emphasis on Key Processes and PLTS and have Functional Maths tasks embedded.

Students are taught in form groups initially during the first term of Year 7 and then placed in appropriate differentiated sets for the remainder of KS3.
